









#### Gini Index - Income Disparity since World War II










#### Fertilizer Consumption

(kilograms per hectare of arable land)






# Land Under Cereal Production (hectares) 15,000,000 10,000,000 5,000,000 1962 1972 1982 1992 2002




#### Livestock Production Index

But should they fail in this war of extermination, sickly seasons, epidemics, pestilence, and plague, advance in terrific array, and sweep off their thousands and ten thousands.








### We are oppressed







#### inflation-adjusted per capita GDP




